The registration fee covers meals, accomodation and extras.

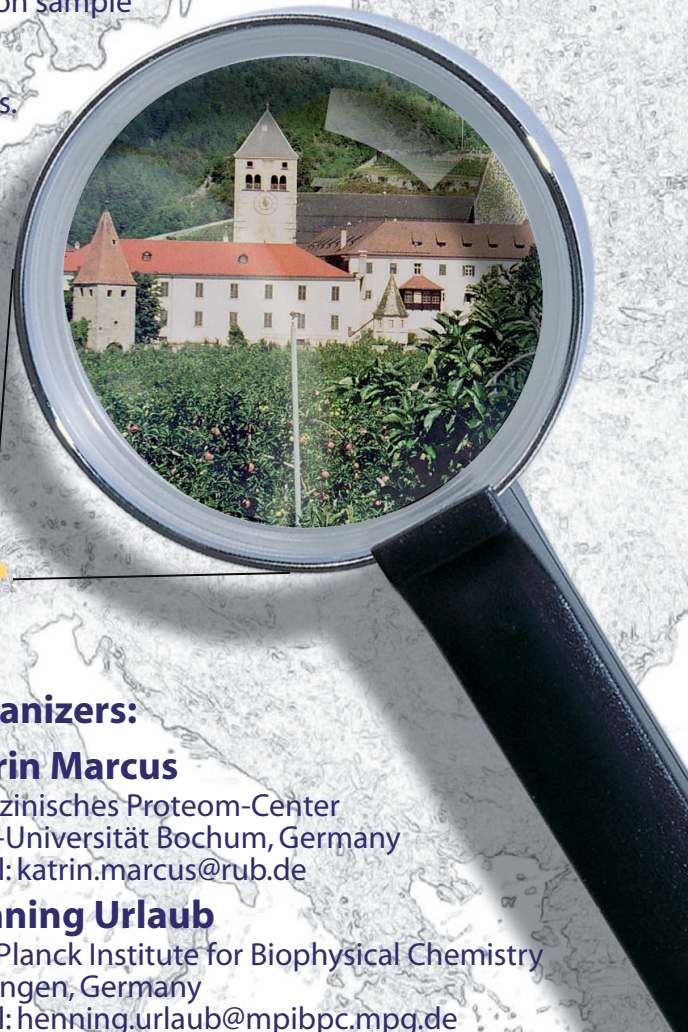
Participants are responsible for meeting their own travel expenses.
